Challenge

To meet the city's need, among so many security products, the Ministry of Security chose the body camera that is easy to use and manage, it is also a product widely used in Latin America. Ministry of security does not need users to operate the equipment, they need a body camera that can record many hours at a time, thus to have the evidence, deter crime and improve the security of the city.

Due to the design of the equipment, the Ministry of Security asks that the equipment be robust, the battery and memory card must be internal, not replaceable, to avoid internal theft.



Solution

Among many competitors, in the end the Ministry of Security chose ViPRO's solution, BV-A12S body camera. BV-A12s has a wide angle of 127°, which allows you to take video and audio capture in any type of condition, be it day, night or in poor lighting conditions. The collected images are stored in an internal memory that the camera has (in encrypted and protected form). In turn, it contains a GPS to have the geographical reference, the date and the time of what was filmed.

And the camera supports H.265 encoding, which helps save storage space, and does not allow the deletion of files from the camera, this function helps a lot to protect evidence, continuous recording more than 14 hours is also great camera advantage.
